St. Henry District High School is Northern Kentucky's largest Roman Catholic college-preparatory, co-educational high school. Serving the Diocese of Covington since 1933, our mission is to produce educated, disciplined and well-rounded men and women of strong character and integrity, who are prepared to meet the demanding challenges of the future. St. Henry High School became a district high school in 1984 and serves students in grades nine through twelve. Students come from numerous counties in the Northern Kentucky area as well as adjacent counties in Indiana and represent our district elementary schools as well as other faith traditions.

CURRICULUM

The **academic program** is organized into a seven-period day with classes meeting five times per week for 45-minute periods. The school year is in session from the middle of August through the end of May and is divided into two semesters of 18 weeks each.

Twenty-four credits are required for graduation.

These credits must include the following:

English (4) Religion (4) Mathematics (4) Social Studies (3) Science (3) Fine Arts (1) PE/Health (1) Global & Digital Citizenship (1) Electives (3) Required Community Service (75 hours)

Advanced Placement (AP) courses are offered in U.S. History, World History, Latin, U.S. Government & Politics, European History, Human Geography, Psychology, English Language, English Literature, Spanish Language, Spanish Literature, Biology, Chemistry, Physics, Statistics, Calculus, Computer Science, Drawing, 2-D Art and Design.

Honors courses are offered in English I, II, and III, STEM Explorations, Biology, Chemistry, Anatomy, Algebra I and II, Geometry, Accounting II, Precalculus, Calculus, Physics, Computer Science, Cyber Science, World Civilization, Latin I, II, and III, Spanish I, II, and III.

Dual Credit courses are offered onsite and online.

GRADING AND RANKING *A 10-point grading scale was implemented in July 2020. St. Henry District High School assigns number grades using the following system: A = 90-100% B = 80-89% C = 70-79% D = 60-69% F = 59-below AP courses are weighted at 1.08. Honors courses are weighted at 1.04. Dual Credit courses are weighted at 1.08.

*Note to colleges: Grade point averages for the Class of 2021 will be based on the old grading scale for grades 9-11. A=93-100; B=85-92; C=77-84; D=70-76; F=69-below. 7th semester grades for the Class of 2021 will be based on the new grading scale. The cumulative GPA reported at the end of 7th semester will be based on both grading scales.
