When calculating GPA, St. Henry District High School will award quality points for all courses as follows. Grade point averages will be calculated and rounded to two decimal points.






Multi-Tiered System of Support (MTSS)

The CCC program at St. Henry District High School is an is an extension of our Multi-Tiered



System of Support (MTSS). This program checks on the well-being of our students through a mutli-disciplinary approach. CCC encourages collaboration among teachers, students, parents, counselors, and mentors. The goal of the program is to take a positive interest in each student and proactively assess their needs. At-risk students are flagged through a weekly screening process and mentors are assigned to help them set goals for improvement and acknowledge positive progress along the way.
