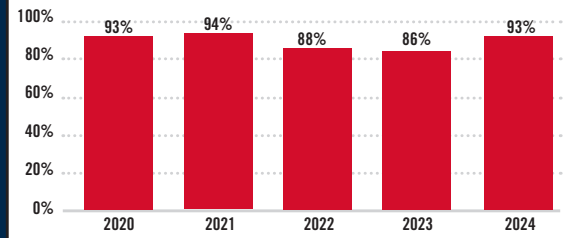
When calculating GPA, St. Henry District High School will award quality points for all courses as follows.

Class Rank

Due to our challenging college-preparatory curriculum and the relatively small size of our senior class, St. Henry District High School DOES NOT RANK students numerically. We believe that number is often misleading because small differences in grade point averages can produce significant differences in rank.

Multi-Tiered System of Support (MTSS)

St. Henry District High School uses a Multi-Tiered System of Support (MTSS) framework that recognizes the joint influence of academic, social, emotional, and behavioral needs on a student's overall educational performance. MTSS aims to address the needs of all learners by providing a continuum of support and intervention so our students can reach their fullest potential.

Academic Achievement through Intervention, Mentoring, and Support (AAIMS)

The AAIMS program at St. Henry District High School serves students who have been identified as having a mild to a moderate disability including but not limited to: cognitive, medical, psychological, or physical conditions that may interfere with their academic performance. Students may qualify for the program based on their academic testing and/or recommendation from their prior school. A student may earn up to four AAIMS credits during high school.



Crusader Check & Connect (CCC)

The CCC program at St. Henry District High School is an extension of our Multi-Tiered System of Support (MTSS). This program checks on the well-being of our students through a multi-disciplinary approach. CCC encourages collaboration among teachers, students, parents, counselors, and mentors. The goal of the program is to take a positive interest in each student and proactively assess their needs. At-risk students are flagged through a weekly screening process and mentors are assigned to help them set goals for improvement and acknowledge positive progress along the way.
